

2020-2021 Quad City Heat Baseball Club Parent / Player Agreement

Please read thoroughly through the agreement form. The following form is a guideline and policy that the organization and the parents sustain in order to keep a good understanding of expectations from the organization to the parents.

- The player fee for all ages is \$400.00 per player. \$200 player fee is due by September 1st, 2020. The second \$200 payment is due by November 1st, 2020. If a player is removed from the team, leaves the team, or the team breaks apart due to the actions by the player or player's family, all money paid is forfeited. Any fees not paid for on time will be assessed a \$50.00 one time late fee.

- Each family will have the opportunity to help pay for the organizational fees thru fundraising. The first fundraiser will be a raffle held in the fall and the second will be a trivia night in the winter. Each player is required to sell \$50 worth of tickets. The first \$25 sold per kid will go towards a *HACK ATTACK pitching machine* available to all teams to use at the indoor facility. The second \$25 sold per kid will go towards the winning pot to be won. **Every ticket sold beyond the requirement will go directly to the player.** The second fundraiser is our annual trivia night. Tables will be divided evenly with participants and volunteers and split accordingly.
 - Every Heat team is going to be required to bring 1 basket worth at least \$150.00 to the trivia night.
- Organizational fees do not cover tournaments, league play and the alternate uniform set. Team tournaments will be decided by teams. All players will receive a uniform set which will consist of 1 uniform top, hat, and pants. Any player that needs a uniform, helmet, or bat bag will be charged accordingly. It is the plan of the organization to purchase a new uniform top, hat, and pants for the player every year going forward.
- Each family must help pay for the tournaments. It is up to the team to determine the tournaments and the amount of tournaments that each team plays in. Teams are required to play in any Heat hosted tournament and help work Heat hosted tournaments if there is a division for the team to play in.
- Teams will have the option to play in the QC Bronco Fall baseball league and the Mississippi Valley Baseball League in the spring. Both leagues are optional and must be paid for by the team.
- Each player or team can get a business sponsor, at different levels of sponsorship, to help off-set most team fees. The sponsor is sponsoring the organization and the organization will donate 4/5 of the sponsorship back to the team on which the player that got the sponsor plays for. Sponsorship money will be used by the team, however they deem necessary, including but not limited to helping that player who got the sponsor with their yearly costs.
 - Probable sponsors will not be applicable for player fees. Fees must be paid ontime.
- Each individual team may determine additional fundraisers for families to help pay for hotels, tournaments, etc.
- Teams (managers, coaches, players) are set on a year to year basis. All players currently in the organization are not required to tryout, but must declare to their coach before tryouts if they wish to return. If the player wishes to be considered for a higher level within the organization, then they must attend tryouts.
- There is absolutely **no** playing for another baseball team (travel or town teams) during the season except for players on the 14u team that plays for their high school team. Players may have to be added to the roster / team during mid-season (after March). These players will not be subject to obligations of playing for only 1 team, though it is stressed by the organization for the coaches to try to find someone that will play solely for the Heat.
- We give each team the opportunity to set team standards for players and families with team based agreement forms.**
- Individuals with money in their account must provide documentation (i.e. receipts), to have money reimbursed. Re-imbusement will only take place after all fees are paid. Money can only be used for expenses occurred for playing with the Heat and must be done during the current season (before the last out is made of the final tournament.) There will be no re-imburements until March 1st, 2021.
- At any time, if attitudes of the players or parents gets out of line, appropriate measures will be taken place by the organization. Actions may include but are not limited to: formally apologizing, suspensions, and removal from team. Coaches or the organization has the authority to hand down disciplinary actions to players/parents. Coaches must speak with the organization first before they lay down disciplinary actions on players / parents.
- Playing time is earned in all games. The manager and coaches have discretion for playing times and positions played.

Please read through the following agreement and sign after understanding the whole agreement.

Our goal is to make sure there is a clear understanding what is involved and what is expected of all persons in the organization.

This agreement is subject to change as deemed necessary by the Quad City Heat Board.
